At 7:12 pm Monday, Sept. 10, the Putnam County Sheriff's Office received a report of an injury motor vehicle accident near 1697 State Route 613 near Leipsic. Greg Brown, 52, of Leipsic, was eastbound on St. Rt. 613 when he attempted to turn left into a residential driveway. Mr. Brown turned into the path of an oncoming vehicle driven by Charles Ellerbrock, 49, of Leipsic, resulting in the collision. Mr. Ellerbrock was transported by Leipsic EMS to Blanchard Valley Hospital in Findlay and later transported by air ambulance to University of Toledo Medical Center. Mr. Ellerbrock's passenger, wife Deborah Ellerbrock, 45, was transported by McComb EMS to Blanchard Valley Hospital in Findlay as well. Their extent of injuries is unknown at this time. They were both extricated from their vehicle by Putnam County Heavy Rescue. The driver and the two passengers of the other vehicle, Aaron Brown, 21, Leipsic and James Pingle, 20, Leipsic, refused treatment at the scene. Assisting at the scene were Leipsic Fire Department, Ottawa EMS, Putnam County Service 301, Leipsic Police Department, and Dave's Repair Wrecker Service of Leipsic. Investigation is ongoing at this time by the Putnam County Sheriff's Office.
